Jane Doherty is respected as one of the nation's leading authorities on psychic experiences.

For more than 15 years the renowned psychic has helped tens of thousands of people understand their past — and future. Doherty, who has been featured by major news media, including The New York Times, The Today Show, CNN, MSNBC, and Fox, co-hosted a psychic call-in radio show for eight years, recently published a new book, and is starring in a new television series, “Dead Tenants,” this fall on The Learning Channel.

As president emeritus of the Jersey Society of Parapsychology for a dozen years, Doherty was named by Woman's Own as one of America's “Top 20 Psychics.”

She provides individual guidance through private consultation, conducts ghost investigations, holds séances to communicate with the other side, and offers classes and workshops to those seeking to discover and develop their psychic abilities. Doctors, accountants, lawyers, police officers and college professors, even Billy Crystal's make-up artist, come in regularly to talk with Doherty.

Her book, *Awakening The Mystic Gift: The Surprising Truth About What It Means To be Psychic*, reveals her personal story and sheds insight on how you can develop the psychic within you.



The Philadelphia Inquirer, New York Post, The Industry Standard, Woman's World Weekly, The Bridal Guide, and numerous publications have highlighted her work as a ghost-busting, paranormal expert. She has also been on Telemundo, the Spanish-language TV network, and by Reuter's news media in Australia, Russia, England, Germany and Austria.

Her ghost investigations have taken her to such notable places as the Lizzie Borden House, Alcatraz, the Palace Hotel in San Francisco, the William Heath Davis home in San Diego, as well as the Proprietary House in New Jersey, the only original royal governor's mansion still standing in the U.S. Doherty has also communicated with the spirits of George Burns and President Harding.

Doherty has assisted law authorities in cases of homicides and missing persons, was retained as an expert witness for a U.S. Postal Service investigation of a major mail fraud case involving psychic claims, and had added to the history of New Jersey when her services were used for an archeological dig. The clairvoyant has conducted over 500 seances, 100 paranormal investigations, and thousands of private readings.

Doherty, 58, resides in South Plainfield, New Jersey.
